Eligible Grades: Pre-K to 4th Grade. *Register based on student's incoming grade in Fall 2025. Pre-Kindergarten students must be at least 4 years old by August 31, 2025, and potty trained. Kindergarten students must be at least 5 years old by August 31, 2025.
